My Health Record & what you need to know



In 2018, a My Health Record will be created for all Medicare eligible Australians who choose to have one.

Make sure you have all the necessary information you need to know about the system.

Information and awareness sessions on My Health Record are being held for your community:

- 2 session times available for Tuesday the 17th July 10am and 4pm
- Tuesday 23rd July 6pm
- 2 session times available for Monday 3rd September 10am and 6pm
- 2 session times available for Monday 1st October 10am and 6pm

This will be free session and designed to encourage informed decision making about your My Health Record options.

Multicultural Community Infrastructure Fund

Applications now open

The Victorian Government is inviting applications for its new \$9.5 million Multicultural Community Infrastructure Fund.

Culturally diverse community groups, organisations and regionally based associations are encouraged to apply for projects that build new facilities, improve or restore existing infrastructure, or increase security and improve accessibility for communities.

The new funding stream will offer large and small grants to support projects commencing in the 2018-19 financial year.

This includes an opportunity for community groups to apply for up to \$10,000 towards the purchase or upgrade of depreciating assets such as fridges and microwaves.
